2004 Society for Pediatric Research Award Criteria

Of Special Note: APS/SPR Travel Grants

The Society for Pediatric Research and American Pediatric Society will award travel grants in the amount of \$500 plus complimentary meeting registration to attend the PAS Annual Meeting. Travel grants are possible to **at least fifteen runner-ups** among the House Officer and Fellow Basic and Clinical and Richard D. Rowe Award categories.

To Apply for an Award:

- ❖ Carefully review the criteria below for each of the awards to determine eligibility.
- ❖ If you wish to be considered for one or more of these awards, you **MUST** indicate your interest by checking the special box on the abstract submission form.
- ❖ Complete the Appropriate Award Application Form(s). One application form/packet must be provided for each award for which you wish to be considered.
- ❖ Include all of the required supplemental materials to make your Award Application complete.

Information About Awards:

- ❖ Only abstracts accepted for presentation will be considered.
- ❖ Each of these awards will be presented during the 2004 PAS Annual Meeting in San Francisco, California.

Richard D. Rowe Award in Perinatal Cardiology

The Richard D. Rowe Award in Perinatal Cardiology was established in 1988 to mark his many personal achievements, commitment to academic excellence, integrity and humility. The award carries a monetary prize of \$1,000. The winning applicant is selected on the basis of both the quality of the work presented in the abstract and the information contained in the sponsoring letter.

Candidates must fulfill the following conditions:

- ◆ Have M.D., Ph.D., or equivalent degree and be within 3 years of completion of post-doctoral education. Individuals who are in the process of obtaining such an education, but have already completed original work are encouraged to apply.
- ◆ First authorship on an abstract submitted to the 2004 Annual Meeting of the Pediatric Academic Societies in the field of perinatal cardiovascular development that has been accepted for presentation.
- ◆ The awardee will present the study at the 2004 PAS Annual Meeting in a related session.

David G. Nathan Award in Hematology/Oncology

The David G. Nathan Award in Hematology/Oncology was established in 2000 by the colleagues, trainees, and friends of Dr. Nathan. The Award marks Dr. Nathan's many achievements in every aspect of academic pediatrics and pediatric hematology, but most particularly celebrates his mentorship of young physicians during the formative years of their research careers. The winning candidate is selected by a committee from the Society for Pediatric Research on the quality of the work presented in the abstract. The award carries a monetary prize of \$1,000.

Candidates must fulfill the following conditions:

- ◆ Must be submitted prior to the completion of fellowship.
- ◆ First authorship on an abstract submitted to the PAS Annual Meeting in the field of pediatric hematology/oncology that is accepted for presentation.
- ◆ The awardee will present the study at the 2004 PAS Annual Meeting in a related session.

Student Research Award

Submit prior to student receiving his/her MD or PhD

House Officer Research Award

Submit prior to the completion of residency

Fellow Research Award in Basic and Clinical Research

Submit prior to the completion of fellowship

These awards honor students, house officers and fellows engaged in pediatric research and are designed to encourage pediatricians in training to pursue careers in academic pediatrics. Winning candidates are selected based on the quality of the work presented in the abstract. The awards carry a monetary prize of \$1,000, and one to three awards are given in each category.

Candidates must fulfill the following conditions:

- ◆ First authorship on an abstract submitted to the 2004 Pediatric Academic Societies' Annual Meeting and accepted for presentation.
- ◆ A support letter from the senior investigator or sponsor.
- ◆ The awardee will present the study at the 2004 PAS Annual Meeting.
