



# Society for Pediatric Research Student Research Award

These awards honor students engaged in pediatric research and are designed to encourage pediatricians in training to pursue careers in academic pediatrics. Winning candidates are selected based on the quality of the work presented in the abstract. The awards carry a monetary prize of \$1,000, and one to three awards will be awarded in each category.

**Submit prior to receiving B.A./B.S, M.D., M.D./Ph.D., or Ph.D. degree**

## To Apply for an Award:

- ♦ Carefully review the stipulations below.
- ♦ If eligible, check the appropriate box in the abstract submission program (Step 5).
- ♦ Complete the Award Application Form.
- ♦ **Support Materials:** Include the following required materials with the Award Application to make a complete packet:
  - A support letter from the senior investigator or sponsor that includes a statement that the work was performed by the nominee and fully addresses the role the candidate had in the work and why the caliber of this study is worthy of a national award.
  - Signed printout of abstract submitted

## Stipulations:

- ♦ Must not have obtained the final degree for the corresponding award level:
  - M.D./Ph.D. and Ph.D. award—must not have obtained the corresponding degree.
  - Medical student award—must not have obtained the M.D. degree
  - High school and college students—must not have obtained the B.A. or B.S. degree.
- ♦ First authorship on an abstract submitted to the 2005 Pediatric Academic Societies' Annual Meeting and accepted for presentation.
- ♦ A support letter from the senior investigator or sponsor.
- ♦ The awardee will present the study at the 2005 PAS Annual Meeting.

- ♦ Award recipients will be notified in February 2005.
