This disclosure must be stated at the beginning of an oral presentation or stated at the end of your written poster presentation. Presentations must be balanced and objective. Please refer to Tulane's Disclosure Policy below.
- If the research is published in manuscript form prior to the meeting, the PAS Program Office must be notified immediately.
- All presenters are required to register for the PAS meeting.
