Our 2022 meeting in Denver was full of positive changes that resonated well with attendees, including a shorter meeting schedule (no Tuesday programming) to a program as robust as ever with 90-minute sessions and Highlighted Themes. All changes were rated positively by attendees and will be carried forward in 2023 including expanded Thursday and Friday programming events.

PAS 2023 will begin Thursday, April 26, and end Monday, May 1 in Washington, D.C. For those unable to travel, we will have a selection of On Demand content available. As you prepare your submission, please remember:

- 1. All submitters are expected to proactively attend to DEI in the planning of session content and presenters.** PAS continues to commit to reaching our DEI goals, creating a more diverse and inclusive program and community. (For more information, please read our PAS DEI Statement [here](#)).
- 2. Start early: Prior to submission, all proposed session participants must submit the following three required pre-submission tasks.**
 - a. Participant Information Form
 - b. COI Disclosure Form (due to recent changes in ACCME requirements)
 - c. Acknowledgment Form

Submissions cannot be accepted unless the above tasks are completed.

3. Consider submitting a proposal related to our Highlighted Themes: PAS will continue to build a program schedule around three Highlighted Themes each year. We encourage creativity as you prepare to present your science and research to build your session agendas. For example, a 90-minute session agenda for a submission related to a Highlighted Theme may feature short presentations, followed by a pro/con debate, then time for small group discussion among session participants. When you submit, please indicate if your submission aligns with a **PAS 2023 Highlighted Theme**:

- a. **The Impact of Policies on Health and Research**
- b. **Addressing & Overcoming Racism in Clinical Care and Research**
- c. **Science is Real: Research, Misinformation, and Trust**

4. Pre-recording. Some sessions will be selected for pre-recording. Pre-recording your session will allow those unable to travel to access your science via On Demand. PAS strives to make more meeting content accessible to the pediatric community and your help in this is greatly valued. More information on this is to come.

5. Collaborate with other specialties. Presentations that cross multiple specialties are always well received by the PAS community. If your science touches other specialties consider reaching out to one of our [Program Committee members](#) to discuss collaborating on a scholarly session with their specialty.
