- Presenter and Moderator Guidelines were emailed to participants last week. The guidelines and many additional materials are available on the PAS Website.

- The meeting officially kicks off on April 30 with several exciting new PAS Postgraduate Courses, a new Ethics course, the APPR/PAS Fellows Core Curriculum Workshop. Any registered attendee can easily go back to their registration notification to add ticketed events at any time before April 30. Look for an email soon with more details about the new courses to share with colleagues. The Opening General Session starts at 4:30 pm Central—the Keynote Speaker will be announced next week!
