

Scholarly Session and Original Science Program Committee Member Roles and Responsibilities for PAS 2022

1. Scholarly Sessions

- Scholarly Session submission window is **Oct. 6-Nov. 8, 2021**. All speakers must be confirmed by the session chair at the time of submission.
- Review Scholarly Session proposals Nov. 11-19.
- A program committee member from each society will be appointed as the lead contact for Scholarly Session proposal selection.
- A random drawing will occur for the order of selection and an assigned date and time for each society's selection.
- Selections occur from **Nov. 29 to Dec 2**. Each society should provide the allotted number of proposal selections and a program committee representative contact that will ensure that the program is formalized appropriately, and the final program maintains the content and quality for which it was selected. Selections will be posted in real time via the PAS website.
- During the Dec. 7 Program Committee teleconference, 1-3pm CT
 - Any final adjustments to selections will occur
 - Committee members should suggest Rounds with Experts options
 - Original Science Coordinating Chairs appointed/confirmed
- After the Dec. 7 Program Committee teleconference
 - Program Committee Leadership Team will select up to six sessions
 - Scholarly Session notifications invitations will be sent between Dec. 16-21
 - Session Scheduling will be distributed for approval early February 2022

2. Original Science

- Call for Volunteers: Reviewers and Moderators Oct. 6-Nov. 8
 A "Call for Volunteers" solicitation is distributed to the memberships of the participating societies and to participants of past meetings. Individuals may volunteer as an abstract reviewer, workshop reviewer, MOC reviewer, moderator, or oral poster symposium discussant. All volunteer categories will be accessible to the abstract co-chairs during the organizational processes that follow.
- Volunteer Review: Nov. 15-Dec. 7
 The Program Committee will review volunteers in their respective specialties.

• Original Science Submission window is Nov. 10, 2021 - Jan. 5, 2022. Note that this year there will be NO Late Breaking Abstract submissions.

• Abstract Review: Jan. 12-25

Reviewers will be assigned to abstracts based on matching selection criteria. The goal is to have at least six reviewers per abstract, including at least one senior reviewer.

Abstract Selection: Jan. 27-Feb. 9

Coordinating chairs analyze the review scores and ultimately select and develop the final programs based on the review outcomes. After careful collaboration with the coordinating chair team, it is the responsibility of the coordinating chair lead to submit the final session assignments online. Moderators and poster symposium discussants should be assigned during this time. Discussants serve as "plants" in the audience to enhance and facilitate audience interaction during poster symposia.

- All abstract assignments must be made by Feb. 10 to allow for efficient use of time at the Feb. 11 Winter Program Committee Meeting.
- Winter Program Committee Meeting: Feb. 11, 2022, 2-4pm CT
 - Any final adjustments to selections are made.
 - A review of the program schedule and any adjustments to original science session placement will be made.
 - Program planning for future years will be discussed.
- Original Science and Moderator Notifications will be sent on Feb. 21
